

Below are the basic supplies needed for all 6th -8th grade students. An additional subject-specific list may be sent home once students receive their schedule.

6th – 8th Grade Supply List

- ICSAtlanta agenda** w/student handbook is *required* (Cost: \$10.00) – purchase during open house and the front office (during the first week of school)

Individual supplies: Supplies students should have daily. Please label them!

- 1 zippered pencil pouch** (*for everyday needs*) * *Refill pencil bag, box, and binders as necessary throughout the year.
 - Earbuds (labeled with first and last name) (*keep in pencil pouch*)
Students should have their headphones/earbuds every day!
 - Handheld pencil sharpener with cover (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - #2 Pencils sharpened (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - 1 pearl eraser (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - 1 Highlighter pen (*keep in pencil pouch*)
 - 6-in ruler (*keep in pencil pouch; needed in Math class*)
- 1 plastic pencil box** (*kept in your locker, used for specific projects*) *
 - Sharpie Marker (*keep in pencil box*)
 - 12-count colored Crayola pencils (*keep in pencil box*)
 - Glue stick (*keep in pencil box*)
 - 10-count classic fine-tip Crayola markers (*keep in pencil box*)
 - Scissors (*keep in pencil box*)

Please get binders ready AT HOME.

Each binder will need the appropriate amount of dividers and each binder will need notebook paper.

Make sure you label your binders with the subject name on the spine and with your name.
Do not label the dividers yet, your teacher will let you know how to label the tabs in class.

- 1" binders** - one for each core subject – colored preferred: Science (**Green**), Individuals and Societies- I&S (**Orange**), Language and Literature - L&L (**Blue**), Math (**Red**), L2/DLI (**yellow**) - **NO trapper keepers**
- 1 tall locker shelf** (tall enough for a binder to fit underneath)
- 5 packs of 5-tab dividers:** 1 for I&S, 1 for L&L, 1 for Math, 1 for SC, 1 for L2/DLI
- Several packs of loose-leaf, wide-ruled notebook paper** – distribute papers to binders (needed **daily** throughout the school year in all classes) *
- 1 quad-ruled/graph-ruled spiral notebook** (math, preferable: **Red**)
- 4 Composition books:** 1 for L2, 1 for DLI, 1 for Design, 1 for L&L
- 1 Arts Journal: Pen and Gear Sketch Diary**, 70 Sheets, 5.5" x 8.5"
- 1 Arts Sketchbook:** 9x12, 60 lb, at least 100 pages, spiral-bound, perforated (preferred Strathmore 400 series)
- Calculators:** 6th Grade: Simple 4 function calculator,
7th & 8th Grade: Scientific Calculator (labeled with first and last name), Preferred: TI 30XS Multi-view or TI-36X Pro

General supplies: **Supplies will be turned into the homeroom (HR) teacher during Open House or the first days of school – do not label.**
